## From the President's Desk ...

For those of you who attended both the '95 and '96 APA conventions, I am sure you noticed that, with few exceptions, attendance at Division 28's events was noticeably greater in Toronto. This expression of increased interest in the Division 28 program was probably the result of a combination of factors including the location, the condensed meeting format for the "science" divisions, and the sponsorship by the National Institute of Drug Abuse (NIDA) of a concurrent miniconvention. As I noted in my second President's Column (Newsletter, Vol 28, Winter, 1996) NIDA is a major source of research support for Division 28 scientists. Thus, NIDA's support of additional speakers and events at the Toronto Convention undoubtedly made the program richer for many members of Division 28. Speaking for Division 28, I thank Dr. Leshner and the NIDA staff for their continuing support of behavioral sciences research.

As I look back over my last decade of close involvement in Division 28's affairs, I am struck by the many contributions of so many able professionals whose unpaid work has made our division an effective voice for science within APA. I thank you all for your previous and continuing efforts. While musing about these matters, I happened to reread my presidential platform statement: "Although the number of active scientists in APA continues to dwindle, it is clear to me that APA needs the active participation of Division 28 to preserve the scientific basis

for APA's political positions regarding psychopharmacology (especially in relation to prescription privileges for psychologists), efficacy of drug treatments for mental illnesses, substance abuse, continuing education in psychopharmacology, the use of animals in research, and related issues." My opinion has not changed, except that the number of APA members with primarily scientific research interests may have stabilized. All the issues I alluded to are under active consideration, and I believe our new President, Marlyne Kilbey, is well qualified to address insightfully all of these issues from a scientific perspective. Marlyne has a wealth of experience in working with APA generally and in addressing issues related to psychopharmacology training specifically. I urge you all to give her your support as she takes on the presidential obligations during the coming year.

### A Short History of Psychopharmacology Training for Practitioners and Call for Action by Division 28 Members

In the 1970's APA's Council of Representatives took a leading role in developing model legislation for licensing of psychologists. This August, Council passed, by vote of an overwhelming majority, model legislation and curriculum designed to enable psychologists to prescribe drugs<sup>1</sup>. This action of Council, like the earlier one, will have major impact on the training psychologists receive and the way in which they practice. It also raises issues for Division 28 members to consider immediately.

## A Short History (cont'd)

Adoption of the model legislation and curriculum is the culmination of work that began a dozen years ago when Senator Inouye (D, Hawaii) suggested that psychology consider the feasibility of including prescribing medications as part of their practice. Senator Inouye's recommendation reflected his perception that large numbers of people were either receiving no pharmacologic treatment or inappropriate pharmacologic treatment for mental and behavioral disorders.

Pat DeLeon, Ron Fox, and other APA activists, mostly associated with the Practice Directorate, helped keep Inouye's idea alive, and it percolated among various groups in the association for several years. In 1989, the APA Board of Professional Affairs heard presentations on prescribing privileges issues from various experts. These deliberations led APA's Board of Directors to establish, in 1991, an Ad Hoc Task Force on Psychopharmacology to consider whether prescription privileges were feasible and, if so, what kind of training it would require.

Division 28's involvement in the issue began in 1988 when George Bigelow, then President of Division 28, established a curriculum committee with me as its Chair. I became aware that there was very little published information about psychopharmacology training for psychologists. I sought the opportunity to insert questions about training in psychopharmacology in the annual survey on graduate education, and I put together a symposium for the 1990 APA convention to present those data. APA issued a preliminary report in January 1991, and the data were also included in the summary of the report of the Ad Hoc Task Force on Psychopharmacology (Smyer et al., 1993). With about 1 in 6 programs responding, 60% of public and 75% of private universities reported offering a course in psychopharmacology. At the internship level, the percentage of programs that included psychopharmacology training varied by site from 26% of the university-based programs to 50% of the programs based at human service institutions. In summary, the survey indicated that some training in psychopharmacology was widely available in psychology graduate programs.

Division 28's interest in curricular issues and my work in developing both the data on training and the symposium led the Board of Directors to invite four division 28 members (Robert Balster, Dan Egli, Nancy Leith, and me) to serve on its Ad Hoc Task Force on Psychopharmacology which was organized in 1991 with the charge outlined above. Other members of the committee were the Chair, Michael Smyer, Dale Johnson, and Antonio Puente. The committee broadened its charge to include the entire

range of training in psychopharmacology and issued a report (summarized in Smyer et al., 1993) recommending three levels of training for psychologists: Level I consisting of basic training in psychopharmacology which was considered necessary for all psychologists providing human services. Level II was envisioned as training for collaborative practice with physicians in the management of persons needing psychotherapeutic drugs. Training for independent prescription privileges comprised Level III. In essence, Level I exposes the student to psychopharmacology, Level II provides experience, and Level III expertise. Training at Level I is pre-doctoral, Level II is either pre-doctoral, post-doctoral, or a mixture of these, and Level III is post-doctoral. The intended students for Level I training are all doctoral students in clinical, counseling, and school psychology programs as well as all currently licensed psychologists in those areas. Level II training is intended for that sub-set of psychologists in those sub-specialties who want to gain experience working collaboratively with physicians to manage persons with a specific clinical problem for which a pharmacologic treatment exists. The target for Level III training is that subset of practitioners who desire the expertise to independently manage persons on psychoactive medications and other drugs which are prescribed in conjunction with them. The Ad Hoc Task Force saw Level I training as basic to both Levels II and III. On the other hand, Levels II and III were viewed as independent and, in fact, involving students with different backgrounds as Level III training requires undergraduate science training that Level II does not.

In 1994 the Board of Educational Affairs (BEA) organized a working group on psychopharmacology to develop model curriculum for Level I and II training. Division 28 members of the working group include Ronald Brown, Charles France, Travis Thompson, Carolyn Mazure, Morgan Sammons, Travis Thompson, Rudy Vachinich, and me. Ed Bourg, Robert Coursey, Carl Eisdorfer, Neil Kirschner, Joan Martin, Jerry Morris, and Tony Strickland are also members of the working group.

In early summer, 1996, BEA made available the working group's Level I, "Introductory Curriculum for Training in Psychopharmacology" that had been reviewed and approved by Council earlier in the year. The curriculum is considered to be the equivalent of a 3-4

hour graduate course, and it consists of 9 modules as follows:

- 1: Biological Bases of Psychopharmacological Treatment
- 2-3: Principles of Psychopharmacological Treatment
- 4: General Introduction to Clinical Psychopharmacology
- 5-9: Introduction to psychopharmacological Treatment of:
  - Psychoactive Substance Use Disorders
  - Psychotic Disorders
  - Mood Disorders
  - Anxiety Disorders
  - Developmental Disorders

Each module incorporates learning objectives, a detailed course content outline, teaching resources, and sample examination questions. Copies of the curriculum are available in hard copy or on disk (2). As of August several hundred requests for copies had been received. An expected outcome of the curriculum is a broadening and strengthening of existing psychopharmacology courses and adoption of such courses in programs where they have not existed.

The working group has distributed a questionnaire to recipients of the curriculum inquiring whether faculty would like to acquire (or upgrade) knowledge in psychopharmacology and, if so, the format of training that would be most suitable to their needs and circumstances. The working group intends to use these data to frame a proposal to the Board of Directors to provide such training to faculty wishing to teach basic psychopharmacology to clinical, counseling, and school doctoral students. There is an urgent need to provide this training to practitioners whose backgrounds will vary as a function of when they received their graduate training and what types of continuing education and experience they have subsequently obtained. I believe that this training can be offered in a continuing education format using APA approved C.E. providers and/or university based C.E. programs. I strongly urge you to see to it that Level I training is offered in your setting, and if I can be of any assistance to you, let me know. In like manner, if you have an interest in delivery of Level I training and have some ideas about how to facilitate its expansion, please contact me.

Work on the Level II model curriculum is ongoing. The working group is developing four modules centered on either special populations (child/

## Family Privacy Protection Act

When the Republican majority in Congress wrote their Contract with America, it contained legislation "The Family Privacy Protection Act", designed to ensure the protection of minors' participation in research by requiring that written parental consent be obtained for surveys covering a variety of potentially sensitive subjects. Currently, decisions about whether to require written consent, oral consent, passive consent, or assent are left to Institutional Review Boards in accordance with guidelines set forth by the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services for the protection of human subjects in research. As there are few risks associated with well-constructed survey research, and the potential benefits from the knowledge gained are substantial, the requirement for written consent is often waived.

So from the start the "Family Privacy Protection Act" is a bad idea. It's a bad idea because it is premised on the notion that the role of parents to protect their children is circumvented by a passive consent procedure whereas current regulations clearly require that even when written consent is waived parents must be informed and given the opportunity to withdraw their child. It's a bad idea because it attempts to circumvent the time-tested procedures for evaluating human subjects research proposals with a bit of legislative whimsy. But bad ideas sometimes turn into bad laws and this one is half-way there.

"The Family Privacy Protection Act" (H.R. 1271) which passed the House of Representatives on April 4, 1995, may not reach the Senate floor in this session of Congress. If it does however, an amendment may be offered that would sacrifice the general goals of risk-reduction research to save the selective interests of drug abuse research. For although H.R. 1271 was designed to increase children's protection from questions in seven sensitive information domains: [1] political affiliations or beliefs; 2) mental or psychological problems; 3) sexual behavior or attitudes; 4) illegal, antisocial or self-incriminating behavior; 5) appraisals of other family members; 6) relationships that are legally recognized as privileged; and 7) religious affiliations or beliefs], proponents of an amendment would single out category number (4) and accord special status to the elements of illegal, (arguably antisocial) and self-incriminating behavior associated with illicit drug use. Thus survey research related to drug use would be exempt from the written consent

requirement. As psychopharmacologists, many of whom conduct research related to drug abuse, we might see this as cause to celebrate. However, focusing on drug use behavior to the exclusion of the constellation of other behaviors that are antecedents or consequences of such drug use seems like an insular, hollow exercise. But we know that. We know that, because we are learning more about these relationships all the time. We're learning about the developmental sequelae and comorbidity of drug abuse/dependence and a variety of other DSM-IV mental disorders. We're learning about the relationships between illicit drug use and high risk sexual behavior. We're learning about the role of family history as a predisposing factor in the development of drug abuse/dependence. Why then would we support any legislation that inhibits our ability to track these complex interdigitated relationships?

Although the amendment has been described as a carveout for drug abuse research, the rumor mill suggests it may narrowly exempt two specific surveys: 1) the Monitoring the Future Survey; and 2) the National PRIDE (Parent's Research Institute for Drug Education) survey. Such a limited carveout would be easier to sell to a House uneasy with any compromise but willing to march shoulder to shoulder with the Senate in the war on drugs. However, singling out these two surveys would advance the interests of only a limited number of investigators and would exclude other equally important databases. For example, as this article goes to press, the results from the 1995 National Household Drug Abuse Survey (NHDAS) have just been released showing an upward trend in illicit drug use (principally marijuana) over the past three years. The NHDAS is an important complement to the MTF and PRIDE surveys because the NHDAS is home-based and picks up school drop-outs who would otherwise go undetected. However, the NHDAS, which like the MTF and PRIDE surveys, has been conducted using a passive consent procedure, has not been mentioned in the context of a carve out.

Interestingly, although the proposed amendment was conceived as a means to selectively facilitate drug abuse research, both the MTF and PRIDE surveys delve into several other sensitive research areas designated as taboo in the original legislation. Although there has been no discussion of further restricting the content areas of either survey, it's difficult to imagine how the sponsors of such an amendment would resolve these logical inconsistencies in a floor debate of H.R. 1271.

APA's position, and the position recently adopted by the Research and Privacy Coalition, a broader

group including science advocacy, public health, education and family planning organizations, is to oppose H.R. 1271 and to oppose any carve out. The organizations believe that any carve out would be far too limited in impact to blunt the widespread harm that enactment of H.R. 1271 would cause.

Whatever form the amendment takes, it is hard to imagine that it could adequately serve the interests of the majority in the drug abuse research community. The proposed carveout for the "Family Privacy Protection Act" appears to have been cut with the Sword of Damocles as this initiative imperils a much broader base of research than the parcel it hopes to protect.

adolescent and geriatric) or specific disorders (serious mental illness and developmental disabilities). The format of each module includes a statement of purpose, learning objectives, professional/legal issues, assessment issues, pharmacological issues for the population/disorder under consideration, treatment issues, research issues, learning resources, and clinical vignettes. Copies of the working documents may be obtained from APA<sup>1</sup>.

The working group has emphasized that Level II training must incorporate both advanced didactic material and clinical experience and that pharmacotherapy must be considered in the context of appropriate psychosocial and psychoeducational therapy. The group has not yet completed its recommendations as to the appropriate length of such didactic training or the proper extent of the associated clinical practica. One of the difficulties the working group is struggling with is the realization that such specialized training might appropriately follow both Level I and Level III training. There is a sense in which Level I and III are alike in that they both offer training that is broad in scope, while Level II training is relatively narrow. Thus, the person wishing to work with a population with ADHD, for example, may need advanced training on the topic regardless of whether he/she has completed a basic course in a doctoral program or a post-doctoral training program leading to prescriptive authority. The training needed by the latter would start, of course, from a much more advanced beginning point than the training needed by the former. While articulating this point, the working group has not formulated a way to develop curricula that accommodates it.

Post-doctoral programs may already exist with substantial training such as envisioned for Level II, but without this aspect being emphasized, and one can certainly envision the incorporation of some of the elements of this training in advanced practicum settings as well as during the internship year. Given the acute need to treat special populations and specific disorders such as those outlined above in a more efficient and responsible manner, it should be possible to devise means to devise means to initiate several demonstration post-doctoral programs for Level II training in the near future. Focusing on a specific population or disorder, a demonstration program might include one week-end of didactic training per month for a one year period and one day a week, over the same time span, of clinical experience with appropriate supervision. I anticipate that Division 28 members will take leadership roles in the initiation of programs of this type, and I

urge you to think what your contribution might be.

The Level III model curriculum for prescribing privileges adopted by Council in August was adapted from work of the CAPP Task Force, chaired by Dan Egli, which, in turn, drew upon model curriculum that have been described elsewhere (Balster, 1990; Fox et al., 1992). It requires as prerequisites for entering the program that one have a doctoral degree in psychology, current state license, and that one practice as a "health services provider". A fourth prerequisite is demonstrated knowledge of human biology, anatomy and physiology, biochemistry, neuroanatomy, and psychopharmacology. Demonstrated knowledge is further defined as successful completion of a planned sequence of courses at a regionally accredited institution of higher learning or evidence of successful completion of a planned sequence of C.E. courses offered by an accredited institution of higher learning or an approved provider of C.E. and passage of an examination covering the content of such a program. The post-doctoral training consists of 300 contact hours in five areas: neuroscience, pharmacology and psychopharmacology, physiology and pathophysiology, physical and laboratory assessment, and clinical pharmacotherapeutics. In addition to didactic work, a clinical practicum is required. It requires that the trainee see a minimum of 100 patients, in inpatient and outpatient settings, for medication, and that he/she receives at least 2 hours/week of individual supervision in the pharmacologic management of these patients.

Up to this point, the seven psychologists who have completed the DoD demonstration program at the Uniformed Services University of the Health Sciences and Walter Reed Medical Center are the only psychologists trained to prescribe. The future of this program is uncertain, and the decision to continue it will almost certainly be as much a political decision as one based on the merits of the program. Meanwhile, the Chicago Campus of the Illinois School of Profession Psychology will offer a post-doctoral psychopharmacology training program beginning this fall that is designed to provide "current utility for the practitioner and...a firm foundation if at some point in the future prescription privileges become available to psychologists".

Enabling legislation for psychologists to prescribe is expected to be introduced in several states in the coming year. They include, Arkansas, California, Georgia, Maryland, Louisiana, Missouri, Hawaii, Oregon, and Washington. Yet, as far as I know, no university based doctoral or medical center-based internship program is instituting a post-doctoral training program to train psychologists for prescription privileges in the near future. I would urge members of division 28 who are faculty or administrators in such sites to begin work to initiate such programs.

With appropriate training, psychologists will be able to provide the proper balance of psychosocial, psychoeducational, and pharmacotherapy that is needed by individuals as they recover from mental disorders or learn to accommodate chronic illnesses. In addition, provided that we continue to build strong research training into all our programs and continue the ongoing dialog between our basic researchers and our practitioners, psychology might just be the science that leads the next big advance in the treatment of these disorders.

## IN BRIEF

The goal of this column is to highlight selected recent research exploring topics potentially of broad interest to Division 28 members. This column describes a study that demonstrates the importance of pharmacokinetic factors in determining magnitude of drug reinforcement.

Nicotine has long been thought to be highly reinforcing. However, until the late 1980s, it had been somewhat difficult to show that animals would robustly self-administer nicotine, leading some to doubt the magnitude of nicotine's reinforcing effects. In the late 1980s, Corrigan and colleagues employed pneumatic pumps with a rapid infusion speed and found robust nicotine self-administration in rats. It was believed that the faster speed of nicotine delivery to the brain via these pumps may have been critical to showing stronger nicotine reinforcement.

Yoshio Wakasa, Kohji Takada, and Tomoji Yanagita at the Central Institute for Experimental Animals in Kawasaki, Japan examined precisely this question of how infusion speed influences magnitude of reinforcement from nicotine, as assessed by self-administration. As they describe in the *Japanese Journal of Psychopharmacology* (1995, vol. 15, pp. 53-59), Wakasa and colleagues compared IV nicotine-reinforced responding in 4 rhesus monkeys across three 8-day periods of access. These periods varied only in infusion speed of each 30 ug/kg dose of nicotine solution: 5.2 ug/kg/sec, 1.3 ug/kg/sec, and 0.3 ug/kg/sec (approx. 6, 24, and 100 sec to deliver dose, respectively). Two weeks of access to saline only separated each 8-day period of access to nicotine. Nicotine solution was delivered via indwelling catheter into the jugular or femoral vein. Animals were given 24-hr access to nicotine (or saline) on a fixed-ratio 5 schedule (5 responses for each drug delivery), with a 15-min time-out after each.

All four animals acquired nicotine self-administration within 3 days when nicotine was administered at the fastest infusion speed (5.2 ug/kg/sec). When the infusion speed was reduced to 1.3 ug/kg/sec, acquisition again occurred within 3 days for three of the four animals but required 7 days for the fourth animal. However, at the slowest infusion speed, 0.3 ug/kg/sec, there was virtually no self-administration in two of the animals, and the other two required at least 6-7 days to demonstrate self-administration. The average daily number of infusions for all four animals during the last 3 days of each 8-day access period were approx. 37, 30, and 13 for the 5.2, 1.3, and 0.3 ug/kg/sec infusion speed conditions, respectively. Number of infusions

was greater during the two fastest infusion conditions than for the slowest condition, which was not significantly different from the number of saline infusions self-administered during the preceding 2-week period when only saline was available. Thus, infusion speed *per se* determined the degree to which IV nicotine was self-administered and, hence, reinforcing. The authors interpreted this effect as comparable to increasing the unit drug dose, since a larger dose would also increase the speed and heighten the peak level of blood nicotine.

This observation of the importance of speed of drug uptake on drug reinforcement is not particularly new. Research by members of APA Division 28 has similarly shown that infusion speed directly affects the reinforcing efficacy of cocaine in rhesus monkeys (Balster and Schuster), as well as of pentobarbital in humans (de Wit and colleagues) and of alprazolam in humans (Griffiths and colleagues). Therefore, in general, the faster the absorption rate (and possibly the faster the elimination rate), the greater the reinforcing efficacy of drugs.

However, aside from adding support to this general relationship between kinetics and reinforcing efficacy, this study by Wakasa et al. may have other important implications. Differences across studies in degree of IV nicotine self-administration in animals may potentially be explainable by differences in infusion speed, as well as other factors (animal strain, etc.). Because of the very rapid uptake of nicotine via inhalation from tobacco smoking, self-administration behavior of the animals in this study during access to more rapid nicotine infusion is a better gauge of the reinforcing efficacy of nicotine from inhalation. These results could help explain the differing degrees of reinforcement in humans from various nicotine-containing products—high degree of reinforcement from tobacco smoking, less from slower methods such as smokeless tobacco, and essentially none from the slowest method of transdermal nicotine patch. A similar relationship between kinetics of a drug delivery system and its reinforcing efficacy has been observed for other drugs, such as cocaine (e.g. smoked crack vs. powdered cocaine). By the same token, slowing drug delivery kinetics may prove to be a useful procedure in developing safer versions of many abused drugs (in terms of toxicity as well as abuse liability) for use as therapeutic medications, as shown with nicotine replacement.

In conclusion, this research further bolsters the point that drugs *per se* are not necessarily reinforcing. Just as environmental context of drug intake can alter its self-administration, consideration must be given to the particular method and route of administration in evaluating a drug's reinforcing efficacy.

Dr. Henningfield is a fellow of our division and is an international expert in nicotine research and addiction.

# Council Representative Report:

## August 1996 Council Meeting

Council of Representatives met in open session on Thursday, August 8, and Sunday, August 11. With few exceptions, the Council concurred with recommendations of the Board of Directors and the various APA Boards and Committees. Items that evoked prolonged attention included a motion (passed) to increase the Compensation for the President of APA to \$25,000/year; a financial forecast that projects a possible \$20 dues increase in 1998 (to be debated at Council in 1997); and a discussion of ongoing initiatives to coordinate strategic and fiscally-responsible planning for APA's future.

The following Council actions are important for Division 28:

### 1. PRESCRIPTION PRIVILEGES FOR PSYCHOLOGISTS

Council approved, without modification and by a show of hands, Model Legislation for Prescriptive Authority, and a statement for Recommended Postdoctoral Training in Psychopharmacology for Prescription Privileges. These documents were developed by a consensus working group of representatives from CAPP (Committee for the Advancement of Professional Practice), BEA, and BSA. The representatives from BSA (Sam Turner and Division 28 member Bob Balster) recommended approval of the models for legislation and training prerequisites and curricula. As detailed in Marlyne Kilbey's column (elsewhere in this issue), prescriptive authority and psychopharmacology training offer Division 28 members a forceful challenge. I encourage Division members to take leadership roles in defining how organized psychology develops and evaluates training for prescriptive authority. ### 2. CHANGES TO ASSOCIATION RULES

The Council approved several minor changes to the bylaws and rules under which APA operates. Each of these changes will be submitted to the membership for a vote in May 1997. All of the changes are housekeeping changes designed to either bring APA rules into conformity with current practice, or to streamline election procedures, and will be accompanied by a 'pro-con' statement. You will be asked to approve

- a. a re-wording of Bylaw Article II: Membership
- b. a change in the timing of APA Elections
- c. a clarification of the meaning of ex-officio

### 3. ELECTION OF NEW FELLOWS

The following Division 28 members have been newly elected to Fellow status in APA: Robert I. Block, University of Iowa, Iowa City IA; Leonard L. Howell, Emory University, Atlanta GA; Mitchell J. Picker of the University of North Carolina, Chapel Hill NC; Timothy A. Roehrs of the Henry Ford Sleep Disorders Center, Detroit MI; and Paul Schnur, Indiana University-South Bend, South Bend IN.

### 4. APPROVAL OF CLINICAL NEURO-PSYCHOLOGY AS A SPECIALTY IN PROFESSIONAL PSYCHOLOGY

Announcements of the specialty will appear within the next few months in the APA Monitor and the American Psychologist.

### 5. IN OTHER ACTIONS, COUNCIL

- a. approved in principle a "Bill of Rights for Patients Receiving Mental Health Treatment", which is being drafted by a consortium of mental health professional associations.
- b. changed the status of CODAPAR (Committee on Division/APA Relations) from an ad hoc to a continuing committee, reporting through the Board of Directors
- c. approved a "Taxonomy for Postdoctoral and Continuing Education and Training in Psychology", which will be distributed to relevant groups
- d. approved a timetable for governance groups to consider the recommendations of the Task Force to Promote Scientific Membership, which has developed strategies to increase APA's science core.
- e. allocated \$7200 (roughly 1/2) from its 1996 Contingency Fund to support the continued activities of the Working Group on the Development of Psychology, which is articulating a series of strategic plans for APA. The targets of the ongoing think/action tanks (TATs) include healing the science/practice rift, managed health care, and the challenges of new technologies, paradigms and products.
- f. postponed until February 1997 discussion of apportionment issues. President Cantor has appointed a 9-member Task Force on Representational Issues, chaired by Ronald Levant, to seek 'a viable compromise to the problem of representation'.

Council meets again in February 1997.

## Women's Network Representative 1996 Report

The primary focus of the Women's Network Representative is to communicate with the Committee on Women in Psychology (CWP) - a continuing committee within the governance structure of APA which has a "women's network" for facilitating communication with APA divisions. The nature of my communication with CWP is twofold. First, it is to learn what they are actively doing to carry out their charge. Second, it is to discuss with them how science, and specifically research in psychopharmacology and substance abuse, is relevant to their larger goals.

One of the major efforts of the Committee on Women in Psychology (and the APA's Women's Programs Office) in recent years has been to organize an APA-sponsored conference in Washington, D.C. on May 11 through 14, 1994.

The conference was entitled *Psychosocial and Behavioral Factors in Women's Health: Creating an Agenda for the 21st Century*. As a consequence of my discussions with CWP and more specifically with Dr. Gwen Keita (Director of the Women's Programs Office, Practice Directorate) research on psychopharmacology and substance abuse was included in the conference's agenda, and I was placed on the advisory board for the conference. In that capacity, I continued to suggest ways in which the study of psychopharmacology and substance abuse plays a role in a psychosocial agenda (and I reviewed approximately 60 of the 700 abstracts submitted for the conference). Symposia were organized on psychopharmacology and substance abuse, and I served as a discussant on a symposium related to psychopharmacology.

Most importantly, as a result of this conference, a document entitled *Research Agenda for Psychosocial and Behavioral Factors in Women's Health* was published by APA in February 1996. This Agenda outlines topics of importance for future research funding. The scientific study of psychopharmacology and substance abuse is well represented in the Agenda which will be distributed by APA, CWP, and the Women's Program Office to all sorts of policy and funding agencies in an attempt to lobby for funding in these areas.

Involvement in clinical research examining the role of weight gain on success of smoking cessation is also possible.
